# .SE

- NIC-SE is the registry for .SE
- Approximately 320 000 domains
- Swedish government pushes for DNSSEC



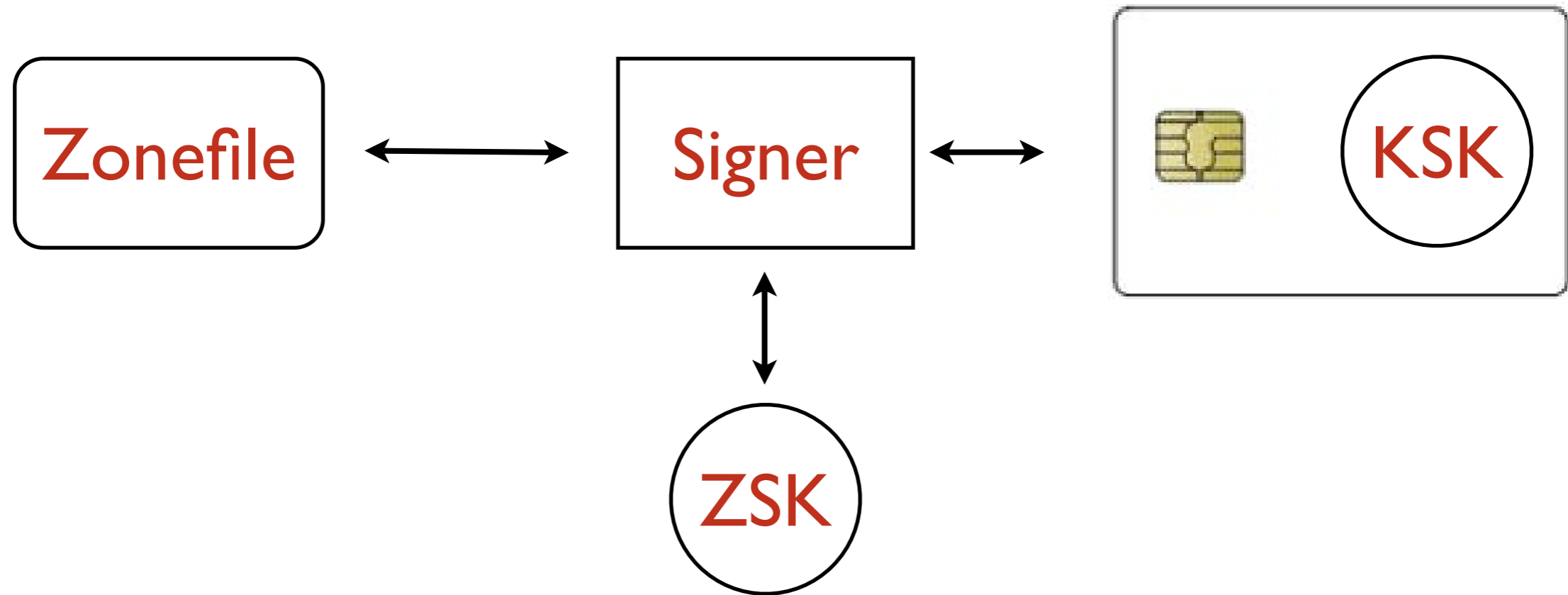


# So far...

- Signed .SE zone in test operation since January 2003
- Key management system development
- Smartcard-based DNSSEC key signer

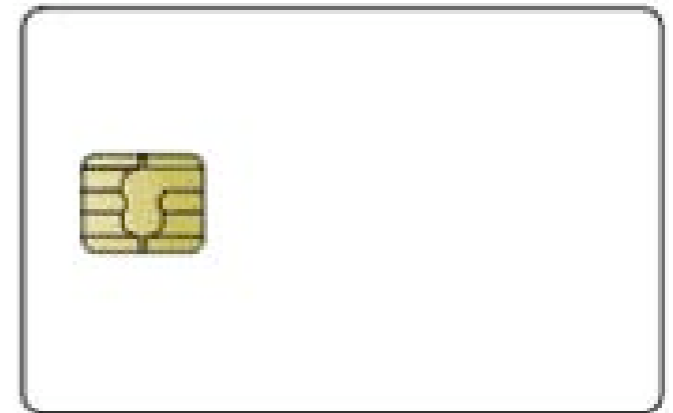


# Smartcard Signing



# What is a Smartcard?

- Small HSM on a plastic card
- Very slow
- Same API as large HSMs
- approx €12 per card





# Smartcard Key Signer

- Signs a keyset using a key stored on a PKCS#15 smartcard
- Open source software available at <http://dnssec.nic.se/sc/>



# What's next?

- Server software upgrade at slaves
  - Beginning of summer 2005
- Signed zone in production environment
  - End of summer 2005
- Key management for domain administrators
  - Late autumn 2005



# Within one year

- Sign important DNS infrastructure
  - Government, mass media, banks...
- Enable DNSSEC validation at Swedish ISPs
- Implement DNSSEC for ENUM
- Launch EPP with DNSSEC for registrars
