



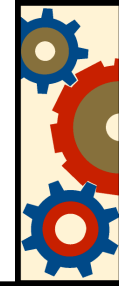

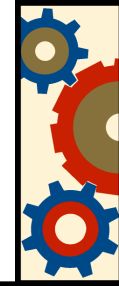
F root

 - Looking for a few more in the near future



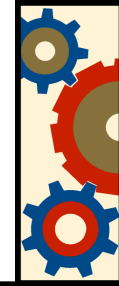
BIND

 - GSS_TSIG



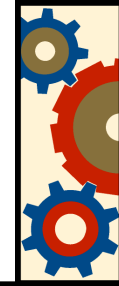
BIND (ii)

 - Upcoming BIND Forum member's meeting at IETF 63, Paris. 31st July 2005

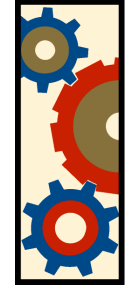
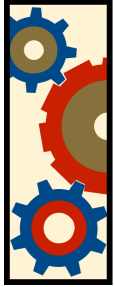


BIND 8



- Recent advisory explained
 - Don't use BIND 8 or BIND 4 as a forwarder
 - Particularly if the receiving end is a windows name server.
 - There is risk of cache poison
 - Not a problem with any version of BIND 9
