Equinix is a commercial Internet Exchange service provider, facilitating both public and private exchange in custom-built, self-owned colocation facilities in the United States and Asia/Pacific.

- ✓ **Founded in 1998 as an operator of IXPs in multiple markets**
- ✓ **Resulted in the largest provider of neutral colocation in the world**
- ✓ **Equinix is *NOT* a hosting company**
- ✓ **Equinix does not own or operate a network or manage services**
- ✓ **Over 1000 networks, content providers and enterprises use Equinix to exchange traffic**



Geographic Presence

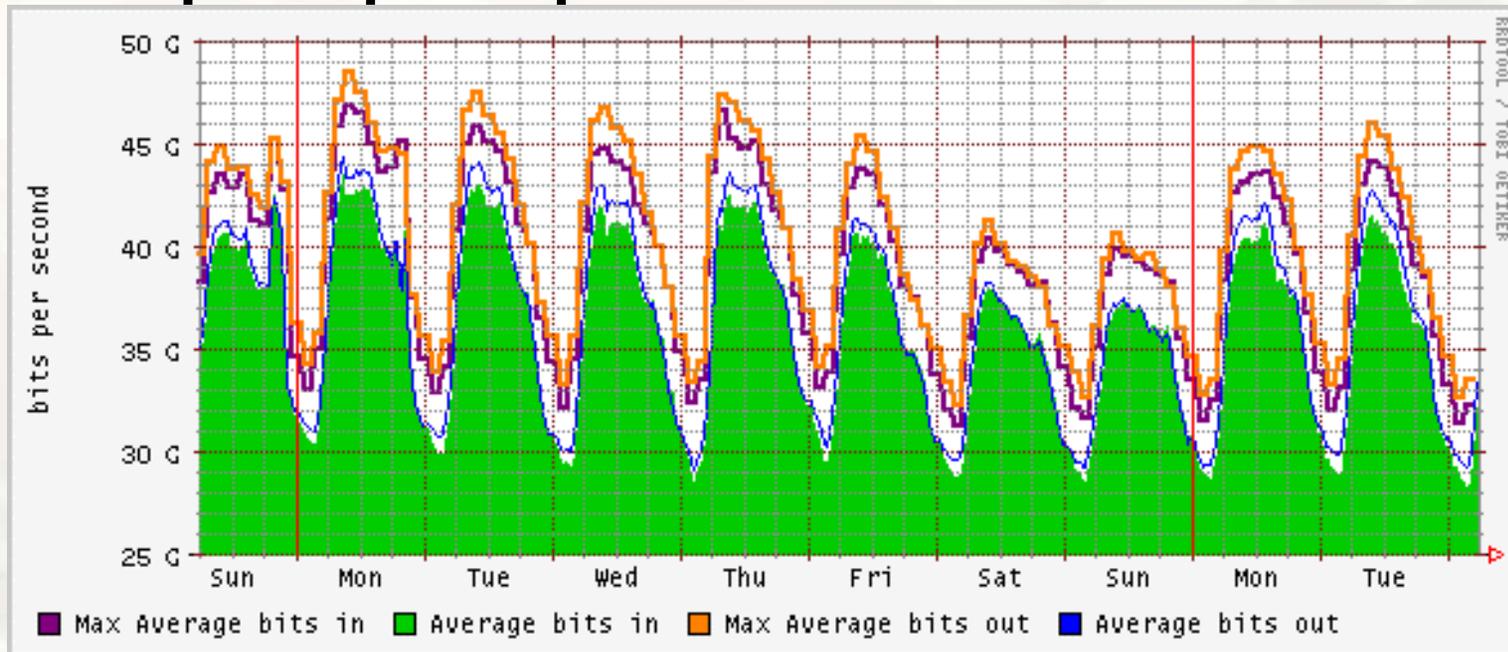

Public and Private Exchange

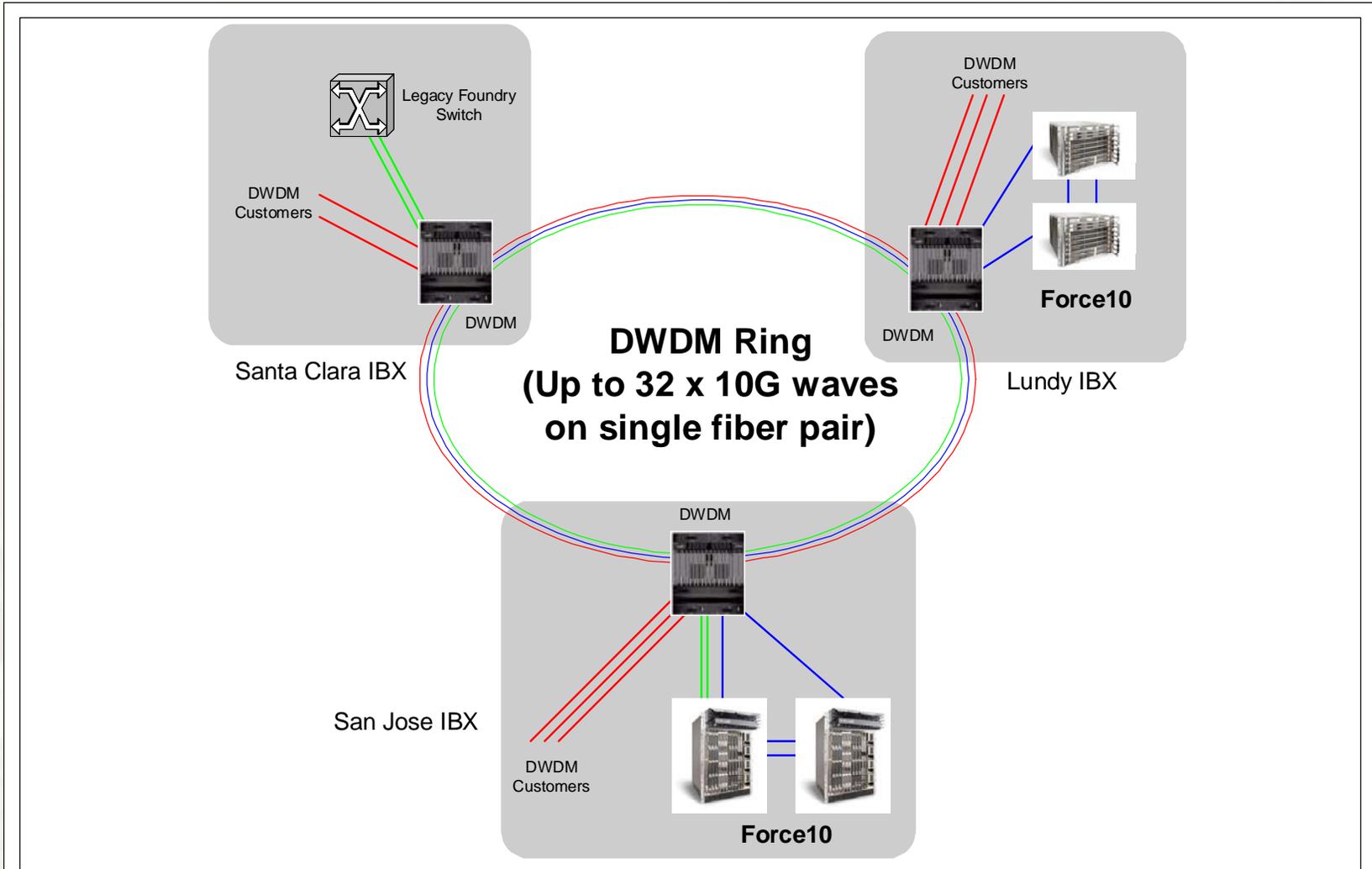
- 342 ports have been allocated to roughly 144 of the over 1000 Equinix participants.



- Aggregate peak exceeds 48gig (traffic typically spread across 4-5 markets average)**
- Equinix currently has approximately 10,000 PIs**

- **Equinix expanded into multiple sites in three metros (Ashburn, Virginia, New York/New Jersey and San Jose/Santa Clara, California)**
- **Equinix expanded the public VLANs of these facilities into the new metro-connected facilities using dark fiber combined with DWDM/Mahi gear**
- **Equinix is rolling out a 10gigE platform in Ashburn, San Jose, Chicago and New York using Force10**
